

In Executive Order 143, Governor Murphy has provided all New Jersey beaches with conditions, procedures and requirements for opening during the 2020 Summer season to prevent the further transmission of the Covid 19 virus.

The help of all Ocean Beach and Bay Club (OBBC) members and renters will be needed to comply and ensure we have a safe, happy and healthy summer.

By accepting beach badges, Members and their Guests, including Renters, agree to:

- 1. Abide by all OBBC rules and bylaws and state, federal, and local laws
- 2. Maintain social distancing guidelines of at least 6' from non-family/household members
- 3. Restrict groups to family/household members
- 4. Stay home if you have COVID-19 symptoms
- 5. Self-quarantine for two weeks when:
 - a. Returning from travel/cruise
 - b. Exposed to someone with COVID-19
- 6. Maintain 6' distance from OBBC staff
- 7. Do not yell, use profanity, or threaten any member, guest, or employee of OBBC

Violation may result in loss of badges and/or suspension of membership, as determined by the OBBC Membership Committee.
